Objective: Students will creatively construct a display of main attributes, life experiences or causes that describe the following person: \_\_\_\_\_\_.

- The students will find objects around their house, cut pictures from magazines or newspapers, print pictures from the Internet, or draw pictures to illustrate the main attributes, life experiences or causes of their person.
- The students will decorate brown bags to illustrate the <u>cause</u>, <u>life experiences</u>, <u>or attributes</u> of their person and they will put all of their objects inside the bag.
- Students will also be required to <u>write</u> a <u>one page</u> essay on their person. The essay must be attached <u>(not glued)</u> to the back side of the brown bag for review by Mrs. Love. Note: Students will be gathering thoughts and ideas and structuring this paper in the Language Arts classroom to help them complete this part of the assignment.
- The students will then present their "Person In The Bag" to the class. It will also be displayed during Bethune Academy's Virtual Wax Museum, if completed neatly and correctly and it's turned in on time.(more information on this to come)

## Key factors that they will be graded on:

- Students MUST hand write any information gathered for their person.
- They MUST collect, make or create at least **5 items** to describe the life and events of that particular person.
- Students MUST illustrate or use 2 photos of the person and their life and how they contributed to the changes in our history.
- The bag **MUST** be decorated.(No BROWN Bags) They are allowed to add anything to their bag. Paint, crafts, glitter...Your imagination is limitless!
- They will also be <u>graded</u> on the **neatness** of the bag and the contents either <u>found around the house</u> or CREATED inside of the bag.
- On either side of the brown bag, STUDENTS MUST WRITE what references they used. They must use at <u>least 2 separate references</u>.
   NOTE: Google isn't a reference.

Students can have an opportunity to check out books from the school library with Mrs. Love or Mr. Harris and can check out a book at any public library as a reference. Students that continue to have difficulty finding information may also see Mr. Harris. A sign up sheet will be posted for students to come in during specials for 15 minutes (except Tuesday) if they need extra help with writing or information on that person. It is the students' responsibility to come and sign up for help with their project if they choose to do so.
